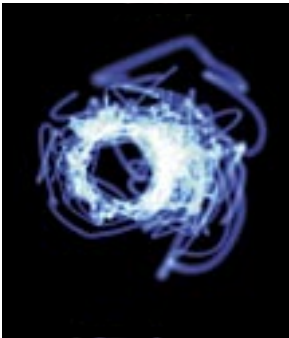

michael shaw : neon aurora

Neon Aurora was realised through collaboration with dancer, Ian Dolman whose movements describing various sculptural forms were recorded using a motion capture system. These traces of motion were converted into brushstrokes in 3D software, Maya to progressively map out a series of sculptures in virtual space according to the rhythm and timing of the dancer's movements.

john coombes : trapezius

Two dusty white figures turn and twist, exploring the space between them in the narrow, black, dark wilderness of the film-frame. They flex their muscles and show off their skills. Hesitant at first, they finally come together. They echo and tease each other, they reach out into the space until they become entwined as one. They come alive together, but can it last? They argue, they fight and their relationship collapses into chaos.

glaub da silva & marcos davi : multiplo

Sky, sea and land symmetrical compounds, create the space. Amplitude. The horizon is the limit (no limit). Escape and detention. On land: A body is going through an iterative sequence, playing in time and space, superimposing itself as an echo of choreography.

compagnie retouramont : dance des cariatides

Different points of view of the performance and various images are screened on the walls of a large building. The audience is included in the device as they recompose by their glance, a multi-angled view of the stage. The subjective images taken by the dancers are also screened on a wall and those images carry a dialogue with a suspended dancer. On the ground, a character uses the same wall to cast a monumental shadow.
